EID AL ADHA JUNE 7, 2025

Eid Al Adha is considered one of the most important festivals in the Muslim calendar, Eid Al Adha translates. to the Festival of Sacrifice. This festival celebrates Prophet Ibrahim's (known as Abraham in Christianity and Judaism) dedication and commitment to Allah (God). Prophet Ibrahim believed that Allah commanded him to sacrifice his son, Ismail, to show his obedience to Allah. Allah intervened in the very last second and sent the Angel Gabriel to replace Ibrahim's son with a ram.

Eid Al-Adha is celebrated world-wide by symbolically sacrificing a lamb, goat, cow, camel, or other animal, that is then divided into equal parts shared among family, friends, and the needy. Learn more <u>here</u>.

Inspired while attending a Mother's Day celebration in Spokane, WA, Sonora Smart Dodd initiated the campaign for a holiday honoring fathers in 1910. Dodd wished to honor her father who was twice widowed and a single father to 14 children. Her commitment to honoring all fathers and their sacrifices to their families was rewarded when in 1942, President Calvin Coolidge encouraged states to observe Father's Day. It is now observed on the third Sunday of June.

Juneteenth honors Freedom Day for the last slaves held in Galveston, Texas. June 19, 1865, is the day when word of emancipation finally made it to Texas. Today's celebrations honor contributions of Black Americans and raise awareness of the legacies and impacts of slavery.

Join the City of Bellevue, Eton School, and The Little School on Saturday, June 14, for this year's <u>Juneteenth Community Celebration</u> at Crossroads Park in Bellevue. This family-friendly event is free and features music, food, and local vendors celebrating and supporting Black businesses.

After a raid on a known gay bar in New York City, riots erupted and lasted for six days giving rise to what we now recognize as the beginning of the gay rights movement. AFFORDABLE HOUSING COMES TO BELLEVUE

Amazon is committing \$100 million toward developing affordable housing for low- to moderate-income families. The groundbreaking in February brought together the many partners addressing this critical need on the Eastside.

Bridge Housing, a San Francisco-based nonprofit affordable-housing developer, is building 234 units near The Spring District on 120th Ave NE. The project is walking distance from Sound Transit's Spring District light rail station. In addition Sound Transit provided the property for the project.





<u>Green Goddess Pasta Salad Recipe</u>

Get your greens and feed a crowd. Make this wonderful recipe for your next potluck or backyard BBQ. Enjoy this wonderful and healthy recipe! And remember to tag @TheSpringDistrict on Instagram when you make it!

INGREDIENTS

1 pound short pasta, such as fusillini or casarecce

¾ cup mayonnaise

½ cup extra-virgin olive oil

2 tablespoons lemon juice, from 1 lemon

1/4 teaspoon sea salt, plus more to taste

14 teaspoon freshly cracked black pepper

2 cloves garlic

1 teaspoon Dijon

1/4 cup loosely packed basil leaves + 6 roughly chopped

2 cups roughly chopped spinach

14 cup roughly chopped chives

½ pound asparagus, trimmed, cut in half lengthwise, then chopped into 1-inch pieces

1½ cups chopped snap peas or 1 cup sweet peas thawed

½ English or 4 Persian cucumbers, diced

1 cup pitted, halved Castelvetrano olives, optional

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Bring a large pot of salted water to a boil over high heat. Cook the pasta until al dente according to the package directions. Drain and rinse under cold water. If the pasta gets stuck together, rinse again under cold water to separate.
- 2. Meanwhile, make the dressing. Add the mayonnaise, olive oil, lemon juice, salt, pepper, garlic, Dijon, ¼ cup loosely packed basil and 1 cup spinach to a blender. Blend until smooth.
- 3. In a large bowl, combine the pasta, remaining basil, remaining 1 cup spinach, chives, asparagus, snap peas, cucumber and olives (if using). Pour dressing over salad, toss to combine and serve. Will keep in an airtight container the refrigerator for up to 5 days.
